1. Approval of CCTC Meeting Minutes of February 21, 2011

**CCTC Member Branham made the Motion to approve the CCTC Meeting Minutes of February 21, 2011, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Lucas, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

2. Update on Raxter Road

**Eddie Murphy, EMA Director** came before the CCTC to give an update on Raxter Road. Mr. Murphy stated that just today he had received news that a \$700,000 FEMA grant had been awarded for Raxter Road with a 25% match which the County could do some in-kind labor. He stated that the process should only take 2-3 weeks from start to finish. Council members thanked Mr. Murphy for taking charge of this project and for his continued hard work.

3. Cindy Lane Extension - Steele's Mobile Home, Ft. Lawn

Has all necessary documentation (survey, deed and right of way)

to transfer Cindy Lane Extension to Chester County – Tax Map 203-02-02-012-000. Mr. Cannon stated this road was in excellent condition. **CCTC Member Jordan made the Motion to accept Cindy Lane into the County system, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Guy, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

4. Road Improvement Project 2010 (ready for bid process)

**LB Cannon** said this included: Doe, Fawn, Snellgrove Roads, Antler Drive, Murdock Road and Murdock Spur.

5. Road Improvement project 2011(for approval)

**LB Cannon** stated that these roads needed approval

Industrial Way, Browns Ferry, Berry Wood, Poverty Hollow, Rodman Park, County Pine, Hicklin, Mayhugh, Phil Grant and Piper Drive.

**CCTC Member Branham made the Motion to approve Industrial Way for the 2011 Road Improvement Program, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Holcombe, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

**CCTC Member Lucas made the Motion pursue Browns Ferry for the 2011 Road Improvement Program, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Branham, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

**CCTC Member Lucas made the Motion to approve Berry Wood for the 2011 Road Improvement Program, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Jordan, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

**CCTC Member Jordan made the Motion approve Poverty Hollow for the 2011 Road Improvement Program, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Guy, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

**CCTC Member Branham made the Motion to approve Rodman Park for the 2011 Road Improvement Program, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Jordan, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

**CCTC Member Holcombe made the Motion approve Country Pine Road for the 2011 Road Improvement Program, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Lucas, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

**CCTC Member Holcombe made the Motion approve Hicklin Road for the 2011 Road Improvement Program, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Guy, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

**CCTC Member Guy made the Motion to approve Mayhugh Road for the 2011 Road Improvement Program, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Jordan, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

**CCTC Member Guy made the Motion approve Phil Grant Road for the 2011 Road Improvement Program, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Holcombe, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

**CCTC Member Guy made the Motion approve Piper Road for the 2011 Road Improvement Program, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Holcombe, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

**Mr. Jeremiah Bradley, SCDOT** presented Council with a proposed list of State Roads for paving for the SCDOT 25% C Fund Expenditures: Forest/Brendale/Catawba, Ball Park (Great Falls), Hill Top Acres, and Forest. These roads were selected by: amount of traffic, condition of road and cost. **CCTC Member Branham made the Motion to accept the recommendations from SCDOT for the above roads to be paved, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Guy, CCTC vote was unanimous.**

**CCTC Member Guy** then asked Mr. Bradley if anything could be done about Stringfellow Road, Ball Park Avenue and Gethsemane Road and Mr. Bradley replied only the roads on the list. **CCTC Member Guy** then asked Mr. Bradley if he would take these roads back to the Engineers and Mr. Bradley replied he would. **CCTC Member Lucas** inquired about Highway 99 stating it had been patched on top of patch and asked what could be done. Mr. Bradley said there was no money.

**CCTC Chairman Roddey** then called on **Mr. Roger Sears with SCDOT** in Columbia to comment on the SC Hwy 9 Solar Lighting Project. Mr. Sears stated they were waiting on a design of the solar lights and may have an answer in July.

### III. Adjournment

**CCTC Member Holcombe motioned to adjourn, 2<sup>nd</sup> by CCTC Member Guy, CCTC vote was unanimous.** Time was 5:45 pm.
