32 1. Approval of CCTC Minutes of May 5, 2008

33 **Councilman Branham made a Motion to approve the Minutes of the May 5, 2008**
34 **Transportation Committee Meeting, 2nd by Councilwoman Guy, Council vote was**
35 **unanimous.**

36 2. Report on polymer product applied to Woods and East Creek Roads

37 **LB Cannon** stated that the polymer product had been put on Woods and East Creek
38 Roads and was working very well and he would be watching it over the next several
39 weeks but he felt it was a definite win/win situation for the County. He said that East
40 creek had 11 or 12 homes on it and **Councilman Branham** said this would be a good
41 test trial on the product.

42 3. Report on roads taken into system off Armory Rd.

1 **LB Cannon** reported that all of the preliminary work had been done on the roads off of
2 Armory Road and the County should be ready to take them into the system.
3 **Councilman Oliphant** asked about Hopps Road, if we were taking the entire road or just
4 to the dam. **LB** said that the area of the dam would not be an official roadway (not
5 paved) just maintenance only and **Chairman Roddey** suggested that he may want to
6 use the polymer product on that portion of the road and see how it performs.

7 4. Update on sidewalk progress for City of Chester

8 **LB** said the sidewalk project was 38% through and that the most congested area had
9 been done.

10 The last item **Mr. Cannon** discussed was the Roadway Improvement Project. He stated
11 that bids on this project were opened last week and there were three bidders. The lowest
12 being LCI-Lineberger Construction at a total bid of \$1,067,684.94. **Councilman**
13 **Branham** asked if **Mr. Cannon** recommended Lineberger and **Mr. Cannon** stated that
14 the same company had won the 2007 project bid and they were very thorough and also
15 that the company had purchased some new equipment and that the reclamation process
16 was a big item. **Vice Chairman Lucas** stated that Ms. Lineberger's Company had
17 worked on a number of projects for Chester County and had always done a good job.

18 **Councilman Branham made a Motion to accept LCI-Lineberger Construction low**
19 **bid of \$1,067,684.94 for the Roadway Improvement Project, 2nd by Vice Chairman**
20 **Lucas.** Discussion: **Councilman Martin** asked if there would be a conflict if he voted
21 and **Chairman Roddey** replied no. **Councilman Oliphant** said he would like for the
22 newspapers – News & Reporter and the Herald, to get a copy of the complete road list.
23 **Council then voted and the vote was unanimous.**
