III. Approval of Minutes

IV. Old Business

1. Request to use non reoccurring funds to install a traffic light at the entrance of GITI Tire, and the type of pole to use.

L. B. Cannon informed Council a detailed letter from the District Office of Transportation should arrive in the next few days stating what will be expected at the intersection. They have also stated the intersection for GITI and Sun Fiber does not qualify for a traffic light under the DOT standards. A traffic study will be done in January or February in 2017 to re-evaluate if traffic lights should be there. As far as the poles discussed at the last meeting, DOT uses metal poles ninety-nine percent. If the intersection is qualified for a traffic light and erected on DOT standards with a metal pole and swag wires and the traffic light signal hanging from the wires, it would be paid for by DOT 100 percent and maintained. If Council decides to put up the lights on the metal poles that could run around \$150,000. Mr. Cannon was asked to contact John McCarter at the DOT office to get more information concerning this and bring that information back to the next Chester County Council Meeting.
