He stated the State adopts codes but this does not give enforcement authority and that Chapter One (1) needs to be adopted or parts of it for the Chester Fire Department.

VII. New Business

1. Road Proposal

Council Member Oliphant stated that the City of Chester had requested that the County receive the road between the old Hardee Building and Mac's Exhaust into the County Road System once it has been decided exactly how far it will go. The City would accept and then deed to the County. Council Member Oliphant then asked Mr. L.B. Cannon to speak on this matter. Mr. Cannon stated that he was looking at this and what ever the City did would have to meet County Specifications and this would be stated in a letter to them. Chairman Roddey then said that the City would pay for this road totally and that the County would not Incur any cost, but it was totally contingent on a Wal-Mart being built on the property. With that being said, Council Member Oliphant made the Motion to accept the Road into the County System only if it was built to County specifications and if a Wal-Mart was built on the property, 2nd by Council Member Holcombe, Council vote was unanimous.

VIII. Boards and Commissions

Appointment to Catawba Regional Workforce Investment Board
 Chairman Roddey stated that Catawba Regional Council of Governments had

requested that Mr. James Nichols be appointed to replace Mr. Dennis Joiner on the Catawba Regional Workforce Investment Board. Chairman Roddey made

the Motion that Mr. James Nichols be appointed to the Catawba Regional Workforce

Investment Board, 2nd by Council Member Branham, Council vote was 5-1 with Vice Chairman Lucas opposing.

IX. Executive Session

Chairman Roddey stated that Council needed to go into Executive Session to discuss:

1. Economic Development – Re: Project 1102

Vice Chairman Lucas made the Motion to go into Executive Session, 2nd by Council Member Guy, Council vote was unanimous. (Time was approximately 6:30pm)

Chairman Roddey stated that Project 1102 had been discussed in Executive Session and Ms. Parker had given Council and update and that it was taken as information only.
