IV. Citizens Comments

Mr. Tom Kellerhals came before Council saying that there had been some confusion about the census and wanted to clarify some items. First he stated that all census takers reported to the Rock Hill Office. Second, they went to homes that did not mail the forms back in. Mr. Kellerhals stated that multiple visits were made some to run down mobile homes, vacant houses, some barns and even a doll house because those were the addresses given. He also stated that since the 1930's Chester County has lost population and until we make major changes we are a dying County.
