TO PROVIDE CONDITIONS PRECEDENT TO THE IMPOSITION OF THE TAX AND CONDITIONS OR RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF THE TAX REVENUE; TO ESTABLISH THE PRIORITY IN WHICH THE NET PROCEEDS OF THE TAX ARE TO BE EXPENDED FOR THE PURPOSES AND **PROJECTS STATED; TO PROVIDE FOR THE** CONDUCT OF THE REFERENDUM BY THE CHESTER COUNTY VOTER REGISTRATION AND ELECTION COMMISSION; TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE TAX; TO **PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS, IN** ONE OR MORE SERIES, TAX-EXEMPT OR TAXABLE, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE AGGREGATE OF \$15,000,000; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY SUPERVISOR TO PRESCRIBE THE FORM AND DETAILS OF THE BONDS: PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE BONDS AND PLEDGE OF REVENUES **RELATED TO THE BONDS: PROVIDING OTHERWISE FOR THE DISPOSITION OF THE PROCEEDS OF THE BONDS: PROVIDING FOR** BORROWING IN ANTICIPATION OF THE **ISSUANCE OF THE BONDS; PROVIDING FOR** THE DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY RELATED TO THE BONDS; AND OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

**BALLOT QUESTION IN THE REFERENDUM; TO PROVIDE CONDITIONS PRECEDENT TO THE IMPOSITION OF THE TAX AND CONDITIONS OR RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF THE TAX REVENUE: TO ESTABLISH THE PRIORITY IN** WHICH THE NET PROCEEDS OF THE TAX ARE TO BE EXPENDED FOR THE PURPOSES AND PROJECTS STATED; TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE REFERENDUM BY THE **CHESTER COUNTY VOTER REGISTRATION AND ELECTION COMMISSION; TO PROVIDE FOR** THE PAYMENT OF THE TAX; TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS, IN ONE OR MORE SERIES, TAX-EXEMPT OR TAXABLE, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE AGGREGATE OF \$15,000,000; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY SUPERVISOR TO PRESCRIBE THE FORM AND **DETAILS OF THE BONDS: PROVIDING FOR THE** PAYMENT OF THE BONDS AND PLEDGE OF REVENUES **RELATED** TO THE **BONDS**; PROVIDING **OTHERWISE** FOR THE DISPOSITION OF THE PROCEEDS OF THE BONDS: PROVIDING FOR BORROWING IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF THE **BONDS; PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSITION OF** PROPERTY RELATED TO THE BONDS; AND **OTHER RELATED MATTERS.**
