- 3. Minimum setback from all residential property lines of 500 feet
- 4. 10 vehicles or campers per acre
- 5. Each campsite identified by number
- 6. Site plan approval from DHEC-Regs 61-39
- 7. SCDOT road standards-CCCO-46-196
- 8. Conditions imposed for safety, traffic, impact on district
- 9. The use is compatible with the district
