I. Call to Order

Council Member Oliphant requested to add York and Lancaster Street sidewalks to the agenda and put this in the form of a Motion, 2nd by Council Member Jordan, CCTC vote was unanimous.

- II. Old Business
 - Approval of CCTC Meeting Minutes of November, 2009
 <u>Council Member Branham made a Motion to approve the CCTC Meeting</u>
 <u>Minutes of November, 2009, 2nd by Council Member Jordan, CCTC vote was unanimous.</u>
 - Reimbursement for Road Sign Material \$2,623.80
 Council Member Holcombe made a Motion to approve the reimbursement for Road sign material from C-Funds, 2nd by Council Member Oliphant, CCTC vote was unanimous.

3. 25% Expenditures for 2010 on DOT roads SCDOT – Jeremiah Bradley stated that Blaney Rd. and First Street in Great Falls were the two roads 25% of C-Funds would be used for at a total cost of \$245,594.48 if CCTC approved. Mr. Bradley also named several roads that would be done by the State this year with stimulus monies. Council Member Oliphant made the Motion that Blaney Rd. and First St. in Great Falls would be the roads 25% of C-Funds are used for, 2nd by Council Member Jordan, CCTC vote was unanimous.

4. Dennis Corporation

LB Cannon introduced Julie Barker and Tina Feaster with SCDOT in Columbia and Freddie Jackson, Maintenance Engineer with SCDOT in Chester to CCTC members.

Ms. Barker then informed CCTC Members that in the future monies would have to be paid up front for programs instead of after the bidding process and that roads can be added now towards next years budget.

- a) Paving of Saluda St. Mr. Bradley stated that they were waiting to see how much stimulus money would be allocated before he could say if Saluda St. would be paved. **Council Member Oliphant** then stated there was a terrible problem with flooding on that street. Mr. Jackson said that they had opened up a drainage pipe that was stopped up and that should help the problem.
- b) Road Improvement Project 2009 Mr. Cannon said they were waiting on a break in the weather and that they would finish when the weather was better
- c) Ballmenia Road completed and turned over to the State.
- d) Piper Road came back from the State to the County.
- e) Roads & Parking Lot Project for 2010
 - i) Rodman Field (Blaney Rd being paved)
 - ii) Richburg Fire will be done this Spring
 - iii) Stone Road Transfer will be done this Spring
- f) 2011 C Fund Expenditures Pinckney St.??? Mr. Cannon said that CMD had applied for a Grant to do this work so the 2011 funds would not be obligated.
- One Way In-One Way Out Road Council Member Oliphant said it would be surveyed and relet and DOT would be involved. Council Member Oliphant also said all property owners, the County and Dot were all in agreement.
- Saluda Street Flooding Council Member Oliphant Mr. Freddie Jackson previously said a drain pipe had been installed and hoped that would alleviate

the problem.

6. District 4 Roads Discussion – **Council Member Holcombe** asked if West Chester road had been repaired and Mr. Cannon said he would look at it this week.

Added to Agenda:

Lancaster St. Sidewalks – Mr. Cannon said they were just getting started on Lancaster Street.

York Street Sidewalks – Council Member Oliphant asked if Handicap Crossings were required (a detectable warning) and were they included and Mr. Bradley replied yes.
