- 1. Lewis Fire Department/Insurance Authorization

Mr. Jay Williams came before Council to ask that the Lewis Fire Department be allowed to charge a fee when they were called to a scene. **Mr. Williams** also said that some mis-

information was also going around that the Lewis Fire Dept. had an ISO rating of a Class 9 but it is really a Class 6. Council Member Oliphant made the Motion to allow the Lewis Fire Dept. to proceed with charging a fee when making calls, 2nd by Vice Chairman Branham. A very lengthy discussion followed. Vice Chairman Branham and Council Member Guy were concerned about fees charged to Chester County residents that they could not afford or insurance (if they had any) would not pay. Mr. Williams assured Council Members that all of these circumstances would be taken into consideration. Council Member Holcombe stated he just could not see the citizens being doubled charged because the County supports the Fire Departments and, as with the Richburg Fire Department, Council doesn't know what the Richburg Fire Dept. does with the monies they collect especially since the County helps that particular department with other expenses. Mr. Williams said the monies would be used to maintain their equipment. Council Member Lucas asked if they shouldn't be required to tell the County how much money they take in and Chairman Roddey replied "no". Council Member Oliphant then asked if they were collecting money shouldn't they report it and County Attorney Winters stated it should be in their audit. Further discussion following and Chairman Roddey finally called for the question. Council then voted and the vote was 5 to 1 to approve with Council Member Holcombe opposing.

Council returned from Executive Session and <u>Council Member Holcombe made a</u> <u>Motion to go back into Regular Session, 2nd by Council Member Guy, Council vote</u> <u>was Unanimous.</u>

Chairman Roddey stated that a Legal Matter regarding Employee benefits had been discussed in Executive Session. <u>Vice Chairman Branham made the Motion to</u> <u>eliminate Section 213 requirement and change from Vested Health to Elkins and</u> <u>Associates for the retiree reimbursement plan, to move retiree reimbursement plan</u> <u>monies from BB&T Money Market to Wells Fargo Trust, to authorize production of</u> <u>plan documents and all effective no sooner than May 1, 2013, 2nd by Council Member</u> <u>Holcombe, Council vote was unanimous.</u>

Chairman Roddey said that another Legal Matter regarding the Magistrate Court had also been discussed in Executive Session and was taken as information only.
