#### 3. FEMA Grant Request

**John Agee- Richburg Fire Chief** came before Council to request to apply for A 5 ton forestry tanker, 4 handheld radios and wildland clothing. He requested a 5% County match totaling \$16,775.00.

**Mr. Agee** also stated that this would not come from the 2012-2013 budget but rather the 2013-2014 budget and if Richburg Fire Department had the funds they would not need the match of\$14,400 for the tanker and maybe not the \$2,275 for the radios and clothing.

Council Member Oliphant made the Motion to allow Mr. Agee to apply for the FEMA Grant with a County match of \$16,775.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Council Member Jordan, Council vote was unanimous.

4. Request to Apply for Fire Act Grant

**Chairman Roddey** stated that the Lando Fire Department had a request to apply for a FEMA Grant for fire hoses and an automated external defibrillator with a 5% match of \$2,875.

Council Member Branham made the Motion to approve the Lando Fire Department to apply for the FEMA Grant with a County match of \$2,875, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Council Member Jordan, Council vote was unanimous.
