PROPERTY); TO REQUIRE THE PAYMENT OF A FEE IN LIEU OF AD VALOREM TAXES BY BUSINESSES AND INDUSTRIES LOCATED IN THE PARK; TO APPLY ZONING AND OTHER LAWS IN THE PARK; TO PROVIDE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT JURISDICTION IN THE PARK; AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF PARK REVENUES WITHIN THE COUNTY

Vice Chairman Lucas made the Motion to approve 3rd Reading of an Ordinance to Authorize and Approve an Agreement for the Development of a Joint Industrial and Business Park by and between Lancaster County and Chester County with Property Located in Lancaster County (The Horton Machine and Custom Design, Inc. Property); to Require the Payment of a Fee In Lieu of Ad Valorem Taxes by Business and Industries Located in the Park; to Provide for Law Enforcement Jurisdiction in the Park; and to Provide for the Distribution of Park Revenues within the County, 2nd by Council Member Holcombe, Council vote was unanimous.

2. 3rd Reading of The Solid Waste Management Plan for Chester County, 2011-2031 Council Member Oliphant made a Motion to approve 3rd and final reading of the

Solid Waste Management Plan for Chester County, 2011-2031, 2nd by Council Member Branham, Council vote was unanimous.

3. An Inducement Resolution regarding an investment in the County by Project 1222, in the form of a new and/or additional facility

<u>Council Member Oliphant made the Motion to defer this Resolution until after</u> Executive Session, 2nd by Council Member Guy, Council vote was unanimous.

VII. New Business

1. West Chester Fire Department

Ben Grant came before Council with plans for a new West Chester Fire Substation and fund raising ideas. Council had drawings of a proposed substation and Mr. Grant detailed what they hoped to do. The cost of the station would run between \$250,000 and \$300,000 and they had \$60,000. West Chester Fire volunteers are selling address markers and would welcome any ideas to raise money. **Chairman Roddey** said he would be glad to cook BBQ and Hash for them to raise money and **Council Member Holcombe** thanked Mr. Grant and Mr. Andy Martin for enlightening Council on their proposed plans to build a new substation and lower ISO Ratings in the West Chester area.

2. Economic Development Update

Karlisa Parker gave Council Members an Economic Development Update which is included with the minutes.
