Council Member Oliphant made the Motion to accept the bid of \$245,000 from Huss, Inc., 2nd by Council Member Holcombe, Council vote was unanimous.

Chairman Roddey then stated the low bid on the roof for the Courthouse was \$144,275.00 from Davco Roofing & Sheet Metal of Charlotte,NC and asked that Council approve this bid. Council Member Oliphant made the Motion to accept the low bid from Davco of Charlotte, NC in the amount of \$144,275,000, 2nd by Council Member Branham, Council vote was unanimous.

Council Member Oliphant stated he was very pleased with both companies and with both bids and that Frank Williams of Pinnacle Architecture had been an invaluable asset during the entire process.
