- II. Old Business
  - 1. Approval of CCTC Meeting Minutes April 7, 2015

Minutes were not available, Chairman Stuart stated they will be voted on at the next CCTC meeting

### **III.** New Business

1. <u>Approval of sidewalk project on J.A. Cochran Bypass, Chester, from Wilson St. to Walmart on the West side. Approximate amount - \$180,000.00.</u>

Chairman Stuart stated the County wants to make sure they meet the 25% in C funds on the public right of way. Lot of increase walking traffic from that area.

L B Cannon stated the preliminary estimate for the sidewalk right now is \$ 178,068.00. The County will give 18 % of the 2015 obligation which needs to be in Columbia by June 3, 2015.

Chairman Stuart stated he received a negative balance addressed to his predecessor from the State and this should meet the 25% for last year and give 13% for this fiscal year. Chairman Stuart stated this was for discussion only.

# 2. Approval of an additional amount of \$50,000.00 for the Dearborn St. Project (C-Project from 2014).

L B Cannon stated the contract will be June 9<sup>th</sup> of this year and be used immediately to cover all the side trees from the post office to the Hwy 21 intersection. Chairman Stuart stated this would be added to the next agenda to be voted on.

Council Member Lucas motioned to adjourn, seconded by Council Member Guy. Vote was unanimous.
